

These Guidelines are courtesy of Invisible Fence

If animal is breathing

Small Masks - Cats, Pugs with flat faces 1-3 lpm O₂

Medium Mask- Small, Medium Dogs 3-5 lpm-O₂ I

Large Mask- Large Dogs 5-7 lpm-O₂

If animal is not breathing

1. Remove oxygen stopper on top of mask
2. Apply Bag Valve
3. Cover green vents with thumb and forefinger and give 100% oxygen by Bag Valve Mask as recommended below:

Animal CPR

Giant Dogs = Give 1 breath every 10 compressions.

Medium to large dogs = Give 1 breath every 5 compressions.

Small Dogs = Give 1 breath every 5 compressions.

Cats or really small dogs = Give 1 breath every 3 compressions

Cats or really small dogs = Place the animal flat on the ground. Then put your hands on either side of the animal's chest, right behind the shoulder blades with your palms over the heart sandwiching the animal's chest between both hands). Compress approximately ½ - 1 inch deep. After 1 minute, check for a pulse again.
